1. Outstanding Issues

- a. Litter on job site: Shawn reported that garbage bags are on the project site now and employees are expected to utilize them throughout the day and at end of each day.
- b. 100th Street concrete driveway approach within project limits?
 - i. Upon field review after the weekly; no, concrete driveway is north of project limits therefore no impacts to concrete driveway.

3. Utilities

- a. Solarus Telecommunications
 - i. 95th Street Relocate underground fiber optic prior to grading construction.
 - 1. Solarus will relocate UG fiber from STA 13+00 to 15+00 on WED (6/22/2022). New fiber will be directional bored UG near the slope intercepts of the project. Solarus will notify Shawn when existing UG fiber becomes inactive (discontinued in-place).

- ii. 100th Street Relocated underground fiber optic prior to construction. New fiber hugs R/W on east side of roadway.
 - 1. Solarus will positively mark the new UG fiber on both sides of the creek such that when sheeting is driven care can be taken to avoid UG fiber and electric.
 - 2. The cutover from old fiber to new fiber will be completed on THU evening 6/23/2022. Solarus will notify Shawn when existing UG fiber becomes inactive (discontinued in-place).
- b. Adams-Columbia Electric Coop (ACEC) Electric
 - i. 95th Street None
 - ii. 100th Street Relocated OH electric prior to construction. New UG electric hugs the R/W on east side of roadway. Joint with Solarus.
- c. Wisconsin Rapids Water Works & Lighting Electric
 - i. 95th Street Facility in area at Sta 15+67 LT. Take care when grading in this area but no conflicts are anticipated. Grade around pole.
 - ii. 100th Street None

4. Maintenance of Traffic

- a. Erosion Control
 - i. Groundwater dewatering of south abutment into settling basin located on 95th St. south of bridge is performing well. Overland flow to BV Creek. No erosion or water quality concerns.
 - ii. Establish Ready mix truck washout for south abutment.
- b. Weekly erosion control inspections
 - i. Conducted EC Inspection on Jun 20, 2022 all looking good.
 - ii. After the weekly meeting I walked the project with WDNR Casey Jones and she felt project was going well and contractor/staff taking necessary steps to prevent and/or minimize sediment releases into BV Creek. We informed the contractor to create a winrow of clear stone on east side of 9^{5th} near the settling basin to help with erosion of silt material into BV Creek. Reduce velocity of sheet overflow from settling basin. Contractor committed to place as directed.
 - iii. Should be done with dewatering sometime this Thursday after abutment is poured and backfilled to top of groundwater elevation. It was mutually agreed that the current

practice of dewatering was performing well and would last until pumping is no longer required.
